2015 Absentee ballot

INSTRUCTIONS: (please read carefully)

All active members in good standing* may vote by absentee ballot during elections if they cannot attend the meeting the day of the election (November 2, 2015). To exercise an absentee ballot, a member shall obtain a copy of the official ballot from the Secretary, (Thomas Pickens) or his/her designee.

After completion of the ballot:

- Print/Sign/and date the bottom of the ballot
- The member shall seal it in an envelope,
- Sign the front of the envelope as well as the **seal**
- **return it to the Secretary or his/her designee either by hand or via**

- It must be back in the hands of the secretary by Monday, November 2, 2015 no later than 6:00 P.M.
- The ballot shall then be kept sealed in the custody of the Secretary until the election at which time the sealed envelope will be presented to the President (or his/her designee in charge of the election) to be opened so that the absentee ballot shall be counted with the ballots of those present at the meeting.
